MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Many who visit see only the beautiful blue water and white sandy beaches. What they don't know is Cancun has one of the highest divorce rates, suicide rates and drug and alcohol addiction rates in the country. It is a city where children are at great risk of being trafficked or used for sex-tourism.


When Back2Back opened the site in Cancun in 2010, we saw a city desperate for hope, where children and families are under attack. God has given Back2Back Cancun opportunities to come alongside at-risk children and marginalized families. Currently, we assist widows and their families, we serve at San Jose Children's Home, the CAT (a government shelter for abused and neglected children), in the poor urban community of Bonfil and in the underdeveloped rural community of Tres Reyes.

When we began working in Tres Reyes, we were serving a widow and her five children, and helping a pastor build his church and influence in the community. After a couple years of getting to know the community of Tres Reyes, we saw great potential for Back2Back to come alongside this community and provide resources they otherwise do not have access to, with the end-goal being to help marginalized families stay together.

This is orphan-prevention.

If we can provide resources to address spiritual, physical, educational, emotional and social needs, hope can be restored and families can be kept intact and this is why we desire to build a community center. Psalm 82:3-4 says: *Defend the weak and fatherless; uphold the cause of the poor and oppressed. Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked.* This is our hope for the Tres Reyes community... and all of Cancun. Join us.

HOW WILL SPIRITUAL NEEDS BE MET?

Biblical Training & Discipleship

We will offer Bible classes and small group discipleship to adults and children living in the Tres Reyes community.

Classes & Seminars

We will use the classrooms and large multi-purpose room to provide larger scale training and Vacation Bible School for families and children.

Christian Materials & Literature

Through our library, children and families will have access to Christian materials, both print and digital.



HOW WILL PHYSICAL NEEDS BE MET?

Food

With a large kitchen, three serving lines, including one outside, and grills, we will be able to provide meals to those who are in greatest need.

Medical Assistance

The residents of Tres Reyes have little access to medical care, so we will have two rooms designed specifically to provide treatment and medicine through local physicians, as well as guests.

Dental Assistance

Dental treatment is a luxury few can afford in Tres Reyes. We will seek local dental professionals to donate services, as well as dentists who serve on mission teams.

Sports Camps

Used for outreach and to provide activity, children will have access to a soccer field and basketball court.

Playground

We will provide one of the few playgrounds in the area for children to play while waiting for their parent(s) who may be in counseling, serving in the kitchen, in a class or at work.



HOW WILL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS BE MET?

Tutoring

Through the use of local educators and Back2Back staff, we will provide tutoring for children so they can have hope of completing their education and moving on to other opportunities.

Computer Training

We will have a computer lab to assist both children and adults in learning new skills both on the computer and from educational software.

Job Training

We will provide job training to help those who desire to expand their professional potential and/or increase their effectiveness.

Library

We will have a space dedicated to providing exciting, educational and Christian books and resources for the children and families in Tres Reyes.

After-School Programming

Sometimes moms who work need to have a safe place for their children to go after school. The community center will be a place where the children can come to work on their homework, get help from a tutor or just play.



HOW WILL EMOTIONAL NEEDS BE MET?

Mentoring

We will develop a mentoring program that connects Christian adults and teens with adults and children who need a positive role model in their life.

Christian Counseling

We are partnering with a local church to provide Christian counseling for single parents, children and families.

HOW WILL SOCIAL NEEDS BE MET?

Organized Social Activities & Games

Through the use of the outside spaces - palapas, playground, soccer field and basketball court - there will be intentional times when we will guide, direct and coach the children regarding appropriate social skills (good sportsmanship, sharing resources, playing nicely).

Training & Classes


We will provide opportunities for adults to work in the community center, as they learn responsibility and the social skills needed to work and interact with others.




TREYS REYES COMMUNITY CENTER
